Subject: Termination of RadOnc™ Radiation Therapy Benefit Management Program

Dear Healthcare Practitioner:

Thank you for your continued partnership with Presbyterian Health Plan and Presbyterian Insurance Company, Inc. (Presbyterian). Presbyterian is committed to ensuring that you receive information about process changes that may affect your office operations.

Presbyterian is terminating the RadOnc program with HealthHelp effective May 1, 2011. We had implemented this program in August 2010. After evaluating the results, we have determined that radiation treatments generally have been in line with the National Comprehensive Cancer Network Guidelines™.

Some Prior Authorizations will still be required. Please note the following:

- Prior Authorizations from HealthHelp or Presbyterian will not be needed for treatment plans using 2D/3D-conformal radiation, intensity-modulated radiation therapy, stereotactic radiosurgery and radiotherapy, or brachytherapy as of May 1, 2011.
- Proton beam therapy will continue to require Prior Authorization through Presbyterian.
- Treatment by non-participating providers will continue to require Prior Authorization through Presbyterian.
- Prior Authorization requirements for imaging procedures through HealthHelp will not change.
