Explanation of terms in your formulary.

You will see these indicators next to some drug names:

1. **Pharmacy Exception (PE)** -- a drug that requires prior approval before the Plan will cover it, and when the patient meet the established criteria. The doctor must submit a Pharmacy Exception Form. The doctor can submit the request by fax, phone, or regular mail.
2. **Step Edit (ST)** -- a drug that requires a prescription history of specific drugs in the pharmacy claims or data system, and these specific drugs must be taken during a given time frame. After the specific drugs have been taken within the given time frame, online coverage of the newly-prescribed drug occurs at the pharmacy. Step Edits make it easier to access drugs that would normally require a Pharmacy Exception.
3. **Medical Exception** -- Medical Exception -- a drug that is not on the Plan's formulary. Non-formulary drugs require an Exception to the formulary due to allergy, adverse reactions, or no response to all formulary drugs.
